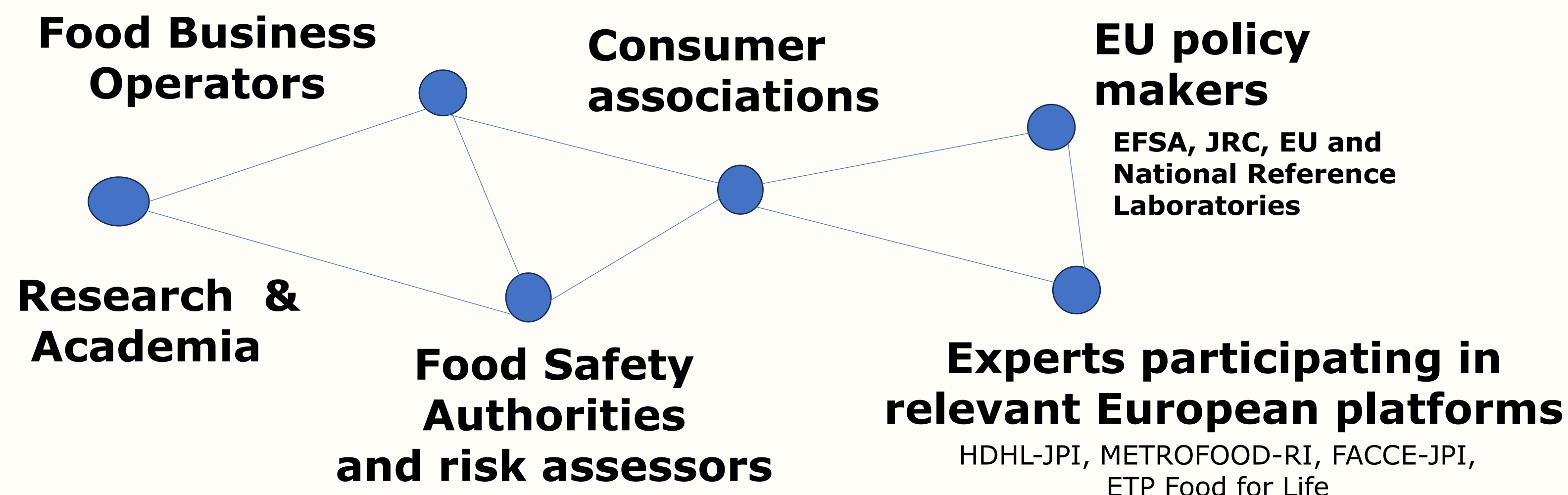

## THE FS4EU PLATFORM

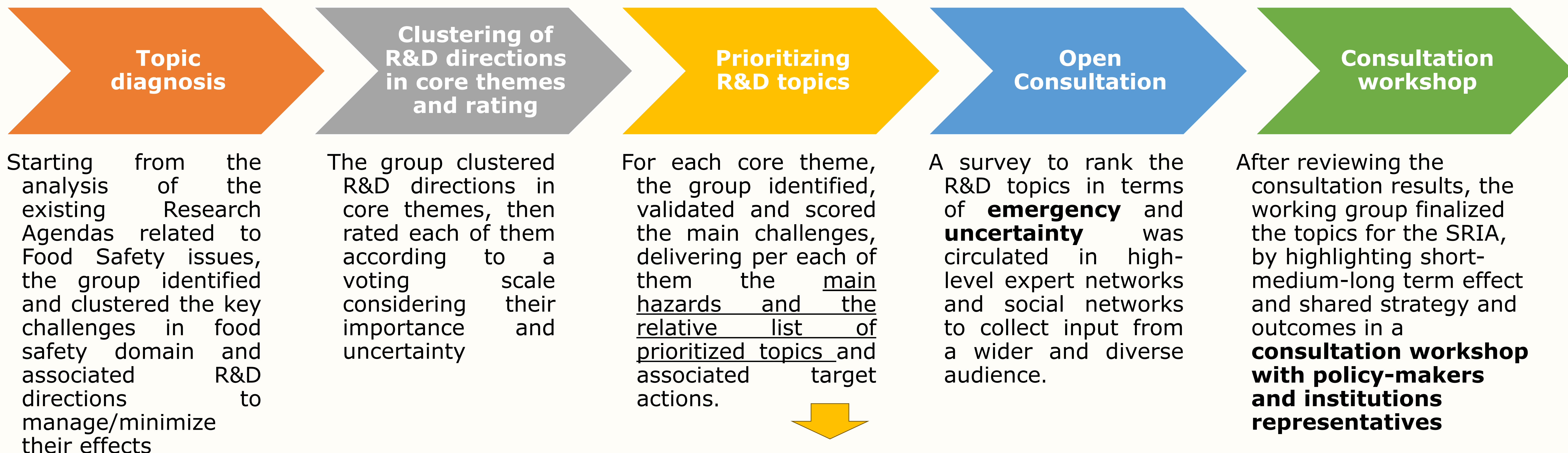
The FS4EU platform is a **collaborative space**, where food safety system (FSS) actors (food safety authorities and risk assessors, scientists, food business operators and citizens) can meet to share knowledge and resources, to interact and network, to create new partnerships and joint activities. The platform is growing as a **Science-Policy-Society interface** by incorporating various elements and engaging multiple actors from the European Food Safety System.
